

Immunization Schedule

Birth - Hepatitis B #1

2 Months – Prevnar #1, Hepatitis B #2, Pentacel #1 (DTaP, Hib, Polio), Rotavirus #1 (oral vaccine)

4 Months – Prevnar #2, Hepatitis B #2 (if not done at birth), Pentacel #2 (DTaP, Hib, Polio), Rotavirus #2 (oral vaccine)

6 Months – Prevnar #3, Hepatitis B #3, Pentacel #3 (DTaP, Hib, Polio), Rotavirus #3 (oral vaccine)

9 Months – Catch up (if needed)

12 Months – MMR #1, Varicella #1, Hepatitis A #1 (as well as a CBC screen for anemia)

15 Months – DTaP #4, Prevnar #4, Hib #4

18 Months - Catch up (if needed)

24 Months - Hepatitis A #2 (as well as a CBC screen for anemia)

3 Years – Catch up (if needed)

4-6 Years – DTaP #5, Polio #4, MMR #2, Varicella #2

11-12 Years - Tdap, Menactra #1, Gardasil series (as well as an anemia CBC screen for menstruating females)

The AAP recommends doing **hearing and vision screening** at ages 4, 5, 6, 8, 10, 12, 15, and 18 yrs
The AAP recommends doing a **lipid screen** (cholesterol and triglycerides) between ages 9-11 yrs

Menactra #2 booster 5 years after first dose (usually at age 16)

Booster of Prevnar 13 for ages 1-5 years who received Prevnar 7

Every 10 years – Tetanus booster (one Tdap booster for continued Pertussis coverage)

Every year – Influenza (nasal mist or injectable vaccine)

Pentacel = combination vaccine with DTaP, Hib, and Polio

DTaP = Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis

Prevnar = *Streptococcus pneumoniae* 13 valent

Hib = *Haemophilus influenzae* type b

MMR = Measles, Mumps, Rubella

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
